Dear Parent,

Thank you for choosing our studio for your child's dance education. It is our commitment to provide comprehensive individual instruction to all students to empower & build self-esteem while growing both mentally and physically. We are excited that your child will be part of our Studio D family & look forward to an awesome year. Please make sure you read over the entire packet which contains important & useful information for the dance season. We will hand out monthly newsletters & important emails that will keep you up to date with the latest studio information....Please read them. PLEASE LIKE OUR FACEBOOK PAGE AS WELL FOR UPDATES.

Tuition & Billing : A registration fee is due yearly upon enrolment & non-refundable

1. Tuition is due in advance on the 1st of each month. Tuition received after the 10th date of the month will have a \$20.00 late fee added & if not paid it will be added to your next month's tuition. **Weekends & Holidays are no exception!** Any Student who is more than one month behind on tuition will not be allowed to attend classes unless you have personally made arrangements with Mrs.Karyn. All Tuition is based upon the total yearly cost of the program (some months having four weeks and some having five, extra practices for recital, father daughter, etc.) & divided into monthly installments based on a **9 month dance year** (September - May). **There will be NO deductions made in tuition due to holidays or illness.** To avoid a late fee, you may mail your payments to: 281 Country Lane Drive, Lumberton Tx. 77657. All returned check will have a \$25.00 fee added to the. **Refunds or make-up classes will not be given for absences or withdrawals during the month. Arrangements will be made in the form of refunds or make-up classes if classes are cancelled due to bad weather.** A parent must give a 2 week written notice for withdrawal from classes. **No refunds will be given for registration fee, recital fee, costume or tuition!**
2. Tuition prices are 1st class is \$70.00 and each additional class is \$40.00. Second family member's first class will be a discounted rate of \$50.00 and each additional class is \$35.00.
3. For your convenience, we are able to take payment in the form of cash, check, or credit card. Credit card fees are \$3.00 for transactions \$70.00 - \$100.00 and \$5.00 for transactions over \$100- \$150- over \$150 will be a 3% of tuition. There is a payment box located in the office for you to drop off checks. If you are paying with cash, please pay one of our office personnel and get a receipt. You may also sign up for monthly auto draft.
4. If you wish for us to draft your monthly tuition from card on file please sign here: _____ giving us permission to do so on the 10th of each month.

Recital Information: Recital participation is not required, but highly encouraged

5. Our yearly 2024 Recital will be held at the Julie Roger Theatre on May 19th-22nd. Each dancer will need to pay a Recital Fee of \$125.00 per dancer (or \$175.00 per family) by September 27th to help defer the Studio's Theatre cost & other expenses. A costume deposit will be due in October \$60.00 per costume & the remaining balance of \$45.00 (per costume) for child sizes XSmall-Medium & \$60.00 (per costume) for Large Child- adult sizes due in November. **No costumes will be ordered without payment!** Each studio family will receive 2 free tickets for recital. Any additional tickets can be purchased for \$15.00 each. Tickets will be available for online sales in April or May 2024. **All recital & costumes fees are non -refundable. No exceptions to this RULE!** All staging ,dress rehearsal & Recital night are mandatory practice dates at the Julie Rogers Theatre. All Daycare dancers will need to make arrangement to get to & from all recital dates.
6. If you participate in recital maxim of 3 absences will be allowed after January 3rd!

Studio Rules & Regulations:

7. Students should arrive at the studio no earlier than 15 minutes before class **& should be picked up no later than 15 minutes after classes are over..... Please remember this is not a Day Care facility & all staff members are teaching classes or doing other duties.** Students should remain inside the building until a parent comes in to get them. Please do not have your child stand outside in front of studio to wait for you to arrive at the studio to pick him or her up. This rule is because we love your children & care about their safety!
8. Please make sure your dancer is wearing some type of cover up to & from the studio. **No dance shoes should ever be worn outside!!!!** This not only ruins your shoes, it tracks dirt on to the dance floors.
9. Please have your dancer go to the bathroom before classes start, even if little ones say they don't need to ...please make them try!
10. Students must remain in the dressing room before class begins. The office area is NOT a dressing room & neither are the restrooms.
11. The studio dressing room & lobby area is NOT a play area so please keep small children & students quiet while classes are in progress.
12. Absolutely no smoking! Gum is not allowed anywhere in the building. Drinks & snacks are allowed in the dressing area for those girls who stay for an extended period of time. You will be expected to please clean up after yourself & put your trash in the trash cans. Help keep our studio neat & clean.
13. Cell phones will not be allowed in the dance rooms for any reason. They must remain in dressing room on silent or vibrate. Cell phones found in dance room will be taken up & a parent must come to pickup from teacher. If there is an emergency, please call studio phone to speak to your child. The studio will not be responsible for any left, lost or stolen items. **Please put your child's name on everything (shoes, dance attire, bags, etc...)**
14. No visitors allowed in classes. *We will have a parent day for Tiny-Tot level classes!*
15. All daycare students needing pick up assistance will have a \$20.00 charge per month added to their tuition. *Parents with daycare pick up students, please make sure they have a dance bag big enough for all dance attire to fit in & zip closed. **Your child's name needs to be on everything!** It is also your responsibility to let the studio know, in a timely manner, if your child will or will not need daycare pickup or has changed daycare centers.*
16. **PLEASE NO FOOD BROUGHT INTO THE STUDIO UNLESS GIRLS ARE HERE FOR 3 OR MORE CLASSES & PLEASE TALK TO YOUR DANCER ABOUT PICKING UP AFTER THEMSELVESTHANK YOU!**

Studio D Dress code:

Proper dance attire is required to participate in class. Hair must be in a ponytail & neatly out of dancers face. Students that continue to not have the proper dance attire & hair pulled up will not be allowed to participate in class. NO JEWELRY will be allowed in class except stud earrings & including iPhone watches. Class attire is listed below. Only purchase what you need for your classes. All classes must wear spaghetti strap, tank or any other short sleeve leotard. Absolutely no long sleeves. Dance shoes must be from a dancewear store. **Shoes from Wal-Mart, Payless, etc. will not be allowed. Cheap shoes don't last, don't match & don't fit properly!** Dancewear may be purchased at Dance Solutions located at 229 Dowlen Rd. in Beaumont (409-860-1984). Their hours are 10:00 am – 5:30 pm.

Tiny-Tot Ballet & Tumble classes will wear a skirted, pink leotard to be purchased from Dance Solutions in Beaumont. Both classes will wear pink tights. Ballet class will wear pink ballet shoes (with **NO TIES** please). Tiny-Tot 4 Ballet class will tumble during class time, so please do NOT wear bows to class.

Ballet Level 1 & Mini Ballet will wear a black leotard with an attached skirt, pink tights, and pink ballet shoes with **NO TIES**. Please try to have hair in a bun for ballet class. If not in a bun, please wear a TIGHT ponytail with no “whispy” hair. **NO SHORTS!**

Ballet Level 2 will wear a black leotard, pink tights and pink ballet shoes with **NO TIES**. Short, black skirts are optional. **NO LONG SKIRTS**. Please try to have hair in a bun for ballet class. If not in a bun, please wear a TIGHT ponytail with no “whispy” hair. **NO SHORTS!**

Ballet Level 3 & 4 will wear a black leotard, pink tights and pink split sole ballet shoes. Short black skirts are optional. NO LONG SKIRTS & NO HOT SHORTS OF ANY KIND! Please wear a dance bra must be black or nude! No wild colored bras hanging out of leotard PLEASE. NO SHORTS PLEASE!

No long sleeve or halter back leotards for any class! A bun is awesome but must be tight ponytail with hair slicked back please for all Levels Ballet classes.

Tap classes will wear a black leotard, black hot pants or skirt, pink Capezio tights, & black tap shoes. Tap classes will need black tap shoes with elastic or buckle only (NO TIES). If you purchase tie shoes for your little dancer please remove the ties & replace with black elastic or please purchase tap ties! Level 1 Tap class **may not** wear lace up oxford style shoes only levels 2,3 & 4 prefer the oxford slip on tap shoes.

Pointe Class will wear ballet attire – black leotard, pink tights and pointe shoes. Short, black skirts are optional. NO LONG SKIRTS. Please speak to Mrs Bethany for style of pointe shoe. Pointe shoes can be purchased at Dance Solutions located at 229 Dowlen Rd. (409-860-1984). Their hours are 10:00 am – 5:30 pm.

Lyrical Classes will need to wear tight fitting dancewear – dance shorts, tights and dance top are all acceptable. All Lyrical classes may wear nude foot undeez. You may wear black hot pants or skirt over leotard.

Mini Lyrical will wear tan Jazz shoes no dance paws tan jazz shoes please!

Jazz and Hip Hop Classes may wear any tight fitting dancewear (from a dancewear store only) Dance shorts, tights, and dance tops are all acceptable. Two piece dance outfits are perfectly fine as long as they are fitted.

Tan slip on jazz shoes will be needed for all levels of Jazz. Please make sure your dancer wears low cut socks with jazz shoes please- not bare footed (Shoes will smell badly without socks).

Hip Hop Levels 1, 2, 3, and 4 may wear any type of tennis shoe. Please make sure they are clean on the bottom, preferably no street shoes. (Help us keep our dance floors clean). Please try to buy a pair jet for Hip Hop class only due to muddy shoes coming into classes last year! NO HIP HOP SNEAKERS FROM DANCEWEAR STORE PLEASE!

Tumble/Acro Classes will need any color of leotard & hot pants over leotard. NO TEE SHIRTS ALLOWED IN CLASS! We will go bare foot in class.

Parents, we need your help to make sure your child is wearing the appropriate clothes for her class, so please make sure they are clean and ready before class time! Please note that our dress code for Ballet and Tap classes has changed. It is very important that you make certain your child is wearing the correct color leotard for her level. No baggy clothes allowed in any of the classes please get your dancer fitted & proper dance attire.

PLEASE HAVE DANCERS NAME IN ALL OF HER DANCE ATTIRE !!
